PARKING - \$10 PER DAY

Parking is directly behind the Esports Stadium Arlington. Please go to the stadium and proceed to the parking attendant where you will pay and then park in the adjacent parking lot. No IN and OUT priviledges.

ADMISSIONS - \$28 adults and \$17.00 children/seniors/military

We ask that you pay in cash if possible. A credit card may be used for an additional \$2 processing fee.

MEET SCORES/RESULTS

PDC scoring will be providing all electronic scoring. Total Scores will be displayed on screens located at each event. A QR code will be made available so that you can watch the scores as they happen LIVE! That link will be sent a little closer to time.

AWARDS

Athletes will be escorted directly to the awards stand after each event. Awards will take place Immediately.

T&T STAGING

Staging will be located in the competition hall. This area is protected under our sanction with USAG gymnastics, so everyone in this area must be a USAG member and have a background check. **NO parents will be allowed in this area.**

Athletes will need to report to staging when their flight time is called. Please only send your athlete with the items they will need on the competition floor. Please have your athletes place their bags against the wall and not on the stretching carpet.. NO parents are allowed in staging. Teams may assign a USAG registered coach or USAG registered athlete to remain in staging to help with your team.

We want to be sure our sanction is valid and everyone on the field of play or in staging that comes in contact with the athletes has the appropriate background check.

TIE BREAKER RULES

TRAMPOLINE - Tie Breaking System

Levels 1-4:

Ties are not broken at this level.

Levels 5-7:

The gymnast with the highest two E Scores. The gymnast with the highest single E Score.

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Level 8 - Open when ToF is not used for Qualification The gymnast with the highest H-score of the 2nd routine. The gymnast with the highest D-score of the 2nd routine. The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine. The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2. If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Level 10 - Open when ToF is used for Qualification

The gymnast with the highest T-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest H-scored of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest D-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of E-scores of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2. If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Level 9-Open Synchronized

The pair with the highest S-score.

The pair with the highest H-score.

The pair with the highest D-score.

The pair with the highest E-score.

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Example of distribution of awards, if a tie cannot be broken

Two competitors are tied for 2nd place.

Award the 1st place medal to the gymnast with the highest score.

The 2nd place medals are presented to the two gymnasts with the tied score.

NO 3rd place medal is awarded.

The 4th place award is presented to the next gymnast, and so on.

TUMBLING - Tie Breaking System

Levels 1-4:

Ties are not broken at this level.

Levels 5-7:

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Level 8:

The gymnast with the highest D score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2.

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Levels 9-Open Qualification:

The gymnast with the highest D-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2. If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Finals

Ties in the final round will not be broken

Examples of distribution of awards if ties cannot be broken.

Two competitors are tied for 2nd place.

Award the 1st place medal to the gymnast with the highest score.

The 2nd place medals are presented to the two gymnasts with the tied score.

NO 3rd place medal is awarded.

The 4th place award is presented to the next gymnast, and so on.

DOUBLE MINI - Tie Breaking System

Levels 1-4:

Ties are not broken at this level.

Levels 5-7:

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Level 8:

The gymnast with the highest D-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2. If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Levels 9-Open Qualification:

The gymnast with the highest D-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest E-score of the 2nd routine.

The gymnast with the highest sum of the total E-score of routine 1 and routine 2. If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

Examples of distribution of awards if ties cannot be broken.

Two competitors are tied for 2nd place.

Award the 1st place medal to the gymnast with the highest score.
